See the bulletin for all the details. Registration deadline is July 9, 2011. I'm coming back from my vacation early just so I can be there!

**The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ:** The most ancient document regarding the Eucharist is St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians. As St. Paul said in today's second reading: "The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ?" The word participation also means partnership or sharing. It implies a unity with someone or something. The Scriptures and the constant belief of the Church emphasize that this unity with Christ in the Eucharist is not just metaphorical but real.

Nowhere is it more clearly spelled out than in the sixth chapter of John's Gospel. Jesus says: "The bread that I will give you is my flesh for the life of the world." The bread and wine truly become the risen Christ. When we receive Christ we become so united with Him that we share in His divine life.

There are many ways to approach today's mystery. One of my favorite ways is to think of it in terms of energy. Think of an acorn and a stone the size of an acorn. They might look similar, but one is full of life ready to break out and grow into a tree; the other will never do anything but be a stone. The acorn has the energy of life within it, and the stone does not. We look at the host. It doesn't look any different after the consecration than it did before, but a whole new energy replaced what was there before: a divine energy that promises: "Whoever eats this bread will live forever."

In today's feast the Church reminds us of the great gift Christ has given us, Himself. What greater gift of love can a person give than his or her own self. May we never take the Eucharist for granted. May we never lose our sense of awe because the Eucharist is so easily available to us.

**Vocation View:** Pay attention to the nourishment you receive from the Bread of Life. Share it with another.

**Some words to live by:** "To forgive is the highest, most beautiful form of love. In return, you will receive untold peace and happiness." (Robert Muller)

**Some humor to survive by:** A bishop, a priest and a deacon were about to be executed for preaching the Gospel in a foreign land. The guards bring out the bishop first and the commander shouts, "Ready, aim..." and suddenly the bishop yells, "Earthquake!" When everyone looks around, the bishop runs away to safety.

Next they bring out the priest. The guard shouts, "Ready, aim..." and the priest shouts, "Tornado!" When everyone ducks, the priest runs off.

By then, of course, the deacon had it figured out. They lead him out to the firing squad, and when the guard shouts, "Ready, aim..." suddenly the deacon yells, "Fire!"

A pastor's advice to those soon to be married: "Keep your eyes wide open before marriage – half shut afterwards."

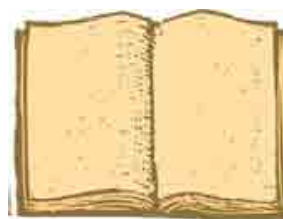
